The Personal Statement is intended to help our team understand your viewpoint and motivations as a writer. The quality of the writing in the Personal Statement will not be evaluated.

1. The *UCLA Law Review* welcomes writing that stems from a variety of personal experiences, values, and worldviews. Such differences include, but are not limited to: race, ethnicity, gender identity, sexual orientation, socioeconomic status, abilities/disabilities, age, religion, immigration status, geographic region, and national origin. If applicable, please discuss how your identity and/or life experiences have influenced your writing and/or your view of the role of legal academia.
2. The *Law Review* editing process involves several stages of editing, and you will be required to engage deeply with each stage of the process if your work is selected for publication. Please discuss whether you will be available to fully participate in the editing process, given your on- and off-campus responsibilities this year.

If applicable, please discuss any support you received from any organizations or other relevant entities, including professors, alumni, or supervisors.
